

How to Combine Sounds (BSV)

Items prepared by customer: SD card (type: SDV-2GP, sold separately), Personal computer, SD card reader/writer

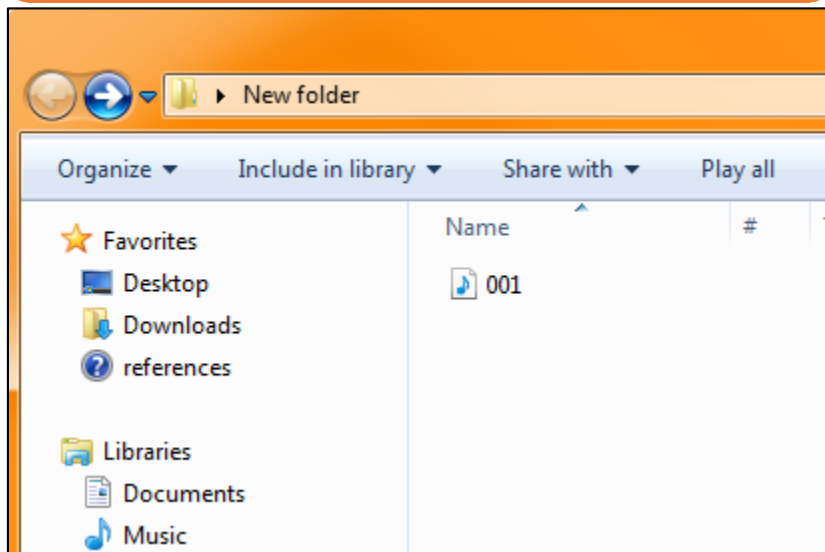
Note: SD card must be formatted in FAT or FAT16

1 PREPARING THE FILE

- Change the [Recording Rate](#) to 32 kbps or 64 kbps
- Change the [Sampling Rate](#) to 44.1 kHz
- Change the file to [mono](#) sound type
- Remove any [ID3 tags](#) from the file
- Repeat for all MP3s desired

Note: Be sure to use the naming convention of 'XXX.mp3'

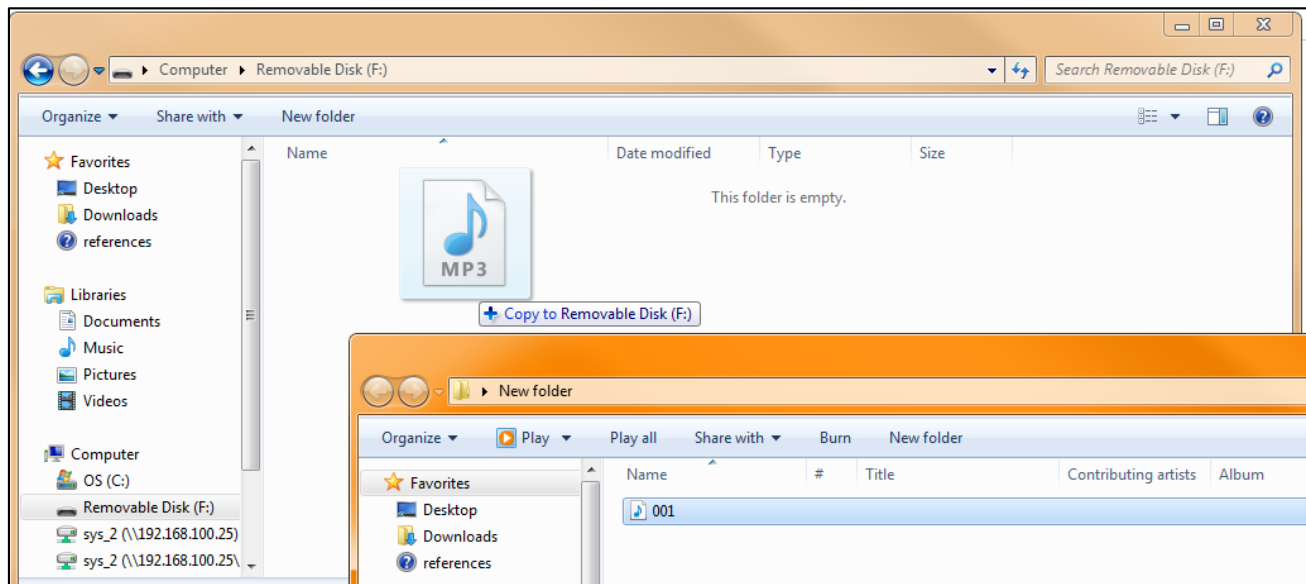
- o Where XXX is a numeric value from 001 to 015
- o Example: 001.mp3, 002.mp3



2 COPYING MP3 TO BSV UNIT

- Connect the SD card reader/writer to PC and insert SD card
- Open the drive into which the SD card is inserted
- Copy prepared MP3 to SD card

Note: Just the MP3 files need to be copied. Copying the folder can result in an error.



- Eject SD card. Insert SD card into BSV unit
- Turn on power to the unit
- You will hear a short beep indicating writing process has started
- When you hear a long beep the process is completed and the SD card can be removed.

Note: short repeated beeps are an error and the process must be started over

Note: if the volume control is set to the minimum, you will not hear the sound of completion
